Greetings CAS-Lyons Members:

It's mid-summer already, yet in the high country snow still covers many sites.

The response to our nominating committee poll from last May/June was reported and tabulated at the June 26th meeting in Lyons. Seven members responded by mail. There were six members in attendance at the June meeting. The combined results were as follows:

- 1) The preferred location for our regularly scheduled meeting is Boulder with 7 votes. Lyons received 1 vote.
- 2) Although all the PAAC classes received at least one vote the most popular classes were Ceramic Description & Analysis, Historic Archaeology, Perishable Material, Field & Lab Photography, Archaeological Dating Methods, and Research Design & Report Writing.
- 3) Eight members said they would be available to take the fall ceramics class with O.D.
- 4) Again all of the activities and/or functions listed received at least one vote. The most popular were surveys, speakers, P.A.A.C. classes and field trips.
- 5) No one objected to our regularly scheduled meetings on the last Tuesday of the month.

At the June 25th meeting an election to install an interim governing body was carried out. The six people present elected David Davis as President, Louise Derr as Vice-President, Peter Christensen as Secretary, Kay Evatz as Publicity Chairperson and Jerry Orback, Robin Farrington and Andi Barnes as Field Directors.

Since only 17% of the membership voted, with no advance notice of election, these officers will serve temporarily until a full quorum election is set and they are confirmed or replaced. These acting officers will also be considered as nominees for those positions, as outlined in the June newsletter.

The goal of our July meeting will be to meet all the candidates for each position, set the method and date of the full election, and adoption of by-laws. Our next scheduled meeting is July 26th on the CU campus in the University Memorial Center, Room 159A at 7:00 p.m. Come and meet the candidates and hear their platforms.
